



## Position Description

### **Part-Time Shift Firefighter**

#### **Position Summary:**

The qualified individuals will serve as an irregular part time firefighter to fill vacant shifts at the Caledonia Township Fire Department. These individuals will not have a regular schedule but will voluntarily work available vacant shifts. They will not participate in paid-on-call responses.

#### **Shift Assignments:**

Shift Firefighters shall sign-up for available shifts after all Caledonia Township paid-on-call personnel have completed their shift selection for the month. Once the shift vacancies are posted for the Shift Firefighters, they shall be awarded on a first come, first serve basis.

#### **Supervision:**

Shift Firefighters will be under the daily supervision of the Fire Chief, ranking officer, or acting officer in charge.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

18 years of age

High School Diploma or GED equivalent

Valid Driver's License

MFFTC approved Emergency Drivers Training Certification

Firefighter I/II

State of Michigan Emergency Medical Responder License (Emergency Medical Technician preferred)

Hazmat Awareness and Operations Certifications

Provide documentation of a Physical Examination that clears applicant for job position

Ability to pass a physical agility test

There is no residency requirement

#### **Compensation and Benefits:**

Position is classified as an "irregular Part-Time Employee" in accordance with the Caledonia Township Personnel Policy. There are no benefits other than the required FICA withholdings and Workers Compensation Insurance.

Compensation starts at \$16.00 per hour and increase to \$18.39 per hour after successful completion of shift training.
